Hot Lunch Menu: Below you will find the instructions on how to login to our Hot Lunch Website. The orders for October are due by tomorrow Sunday, September 27th, 2020. Please do not forget to pay for your orders when you place them.

1. All orders will be placed online at this web address:

central.hotlunches.net

2. To place orders you will need to register first. The access code is ECEHL (these need to be capital letters)

3. Fill in the registration page with your contact information.

4. Add your children to the **correct classroom**.

5. Place your orders. You can do one month at a time or all four months if you wish.

6. You will need to pay for your order with a credit card. We use Bambora to collect money. Unfortunately, we cannot accept cash or cheques.

8. You will be charged a \$0.30 fee to use the Bambora service. If you want, you can pay for all the orders at once to have only one fee.

Picture day will be on Friday, October 16th, 2020. We will be sending home information closer to the date.
